# **Resting in God's Love**

Lesson Text: Matthew 11:28-30

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(New International Version)

28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

### Matthew 11:28-30

(Amplified Bible)

28 "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavily burdened [by religious rituals that provide no peace], and I will give you rest [refreshing your souls with salvation].

29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me [following Me as My disciple], for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest (renewal, blessed quiet) for your souls.

30 For My yoke is easy [to bear] and My burden is light."

# **Lesson Objectives:**

- 1. Understand the invitation Jesus offers to those who are weary and burdened.
- 2. Learn what it means to take Jesus' yoke and find rest.
- 3. Apply the teaching of this passage to our daily lives.

#### **Lesson Outline:**

### 1. The Invitation (Verse 28)

• **Explanation:** Jesus invites all who are burdened or weary to come to Him for rest.

### 2. The Exchange (Verse 29)

• **Explanation:** Jesus asks us to take His yoke upon us and learn from Him. A yoke is a wooden frame used to connect two animals to share a load.

## 3. The Promise (Verse 30)

• **Explanation:** Jesus promises that His yoke is easy, and His burden is light. This means that walking with Jesus is not burdensome but liberating.

- 2. What kind of rest does Jesus promise? (Vs. 29)
- 3. What are the benefits of "rest" regarding Matthew 11:28?
